Day 1: Saturday, June 12, 2027 San Jose, Costa Rica *Pura vida.* In English, it translates to “the simple life.” But *pura vida* is so much more: it's an attitude; a celebration of life in the moment. It's time to experience what *pura vida* means to you. You're on your way to explore a place that's unlike anywhere else in the world, where *pura vida* is an unofficial motto and a way of life. Welcome to the emerald of Central America: Costa Rica. As travelers' arrival times will vary, you have no group activities or meals planned today.

Day 2: Sunday, June 13, 2027 San Jose - Tortuguero National Park Seemingly endless mountain horizons. Complex evergreen forests. These are the wonders of Tortuguero National Park. Travel by boat* to your hotel before heading further down the rivers and canals to the world's first sea turtle research station. Later, have time to explore Tortuguero town with your Tour Manager. Get away from it all and relax at your lodge set in the middle of the jungle, your home for the next two nights. From the morning calls of the monkeys to the gentle chatter of the birds, listen to the active sounds of the rainforest around you. (B, L, D)

Day 3: Monday, June 14, 2027 Tortuguero National Park Begin the day on an excursion to search for the elusive green macaw and other unique winged creatures that flock to Tortuguero. Embark on a nature cruise, getting a glimpse into the habitat of jaguars, manatees, ocelots, and more. The rest of the afternoon is yours to enjoy your Tortuguero resort. Tonight, your group will enjoy an exclusive experience with a local from Tortuguero. He'll share personal stories about his life in this remote village and give you a demonstration of how coconuts are harvested and prepared. Then, savor a local treat – freshly made coconut candy – crafted just for you. (B, L, D)

Day 4: Tuesday, June 15, 2027 Tortuguero National Park - Sarapiquí - San Carlos Take a boat back to the mainland and make your way towards Sarapiquí and Tirimbina Rainforest Center. Today will be an **Impact Moment** as you visit a cacao plantation at the Tirimbina Rainforest Center — an ecotourism destination that is vigilant of environmental, social, and economic impact. Learn the process of sustainably converting seed from bean to bar on a private tour and taste for yourself why it's called “the food of the gods.” Later, arrive at your secluded nature resort, nestled on the edge of the San Carlos River. Stroll the botanical garden lined with fruit trees, including lemon, soursop, guava, mango and tangerine. (B, L, D)

Day 5: Wednesday, June 16, 2027 San Carlos Explore the beauty of your surroundings on a Peñas Blancas River Safari. Paddle and float down the river on a peaceful adventure, taking in the sights and sounds of the rainforest as your naturalist guide describes the intricacies of the wildlife around you. Visit the *finca* of a local family and try homemade snacks such as banana bread, local coffee, and more. End your day with a guided walk through a private, primary forest reserve for a look at the various flora and fauna. (B, D)

Day 6: Thursday, June 17, 2027 San Carlos - Arenal Today, suspended over the rainforest floor, relish a bird's-eye view of the jungle on a guided tour of Arenal's famous hanging bridges. High above the jungle canopies, marvel at natural world around you. Later, settle into your resort where you'll be surrounded by striking views of Arenal's famous volcano for the next three nights. (B, D)

Day 7: Friday, June 18, 2027 Arenal Today, **it's your choice!** Since Costa Rica is the birthplace of zip lining, glide over the canopies on a mind-blowing rip through the jungle **-OR-** make your way across lava fields for an up-close-and-personal look at the volcano on a moderate hike along the trails formed by lava during the 1968 eruption. The afternoon is yours to spend as you please. Perhaps you'll discover the town of La Fortuna or relax by the hotel's pool. Also consider an optional excursion to a family-owned *finca* with an included farm to table lunch. (B, D)

Day 9: Sunday, June 20, 2027 Arenal - Playa Herradura This morning, wake up and smell the coffee at a local farm that produces some of Costa Rica's well-known beans. Take a private tour with local plantation workers and have a chance to discuss what life is like for these coffee farmers. In the afternoon, head to Playa Herradura and settle into your resort for the next two nights. As the day draws to a close, watch the sun set over the Pacific alongside birds in every color of the rainbow. (B, D)

Day 10: Monday, June 21, 2027 Playa Herradura - Manuel Antonio National Park - Playa Herradura Welcome to Manuel

Antonio National Park, home to verdant rainforests and white sand beaches. In this natural wonderland, traverse the trails where the wild things are, or go for a swim in the turquoise waters as wildlife rummages in the canopies. Return to your resort later this afternoon with plenty of time to enjoy its many amenities at your leisure. (B)

Day 11: Tuesday, June 22, 2027 Playa Herradura - Tárcoles - San Jose See wild crocodiles among the mangroves of Tárcoles' Rio Grande. On this exhilarating jungle crocodile safari, you'll boat beneath the towering jungle, looking along the river banks for a glimpse of these incredible creatures. Then say goodbye to the coast and hello to San Jose. Toast to the *pura vida* of Costa Rica tonight over a farewell dinner. (B, L, D)

Day 12: Wednesday, June 23, 2027 San Jose - Tour Ends Bid Costa Rica farewell as your tour comes to an end today. (B)

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices.

Travel with no more than 24 travelers on this tour where a smaller group setting means a more personal travel experience.

Due to the bumpy roads and long drives in Costa Rica, this tour may be uncomfortable for anyone with back or neck issues.

Travelers must be in good health as sightseeing requires walking on uneven terrain; wheelchairs and walkers cannot be accommodated on this tour.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

Costa Rica's tropical climate brings warm temperatures, high humidity, and frequent rainfall.

Rainy season typically runs from May through November, with frequent showers — often in the afternoons.

The roads in Costa Rica are notoriously poor and impacted by heavy rains each season making them bumpy and requiring lower driving speeds. You can expect winding and some unpaved roads along the way.

In order to experience all that we have included on this tour, three of the tour days will require driving and/or a boat transfer with 4-5 hours of actual time in transit.

This tour features four days where you have full days of sightseeing requiring morning departures from your hotel returning late afternoon. Additionally, five of the touring days you will depart your hotel before 8:30 a.m.

We make every effort to immerse you in Costa Rica's incredible nature and wildlife, but sightings cannot be guaranteed. Animals are wild and may behave unpredictably — keep a safe distance, stay alert, and follow your guide's instructions.

Museum visits and shopping may be affected by the observance of religious or local holidays.

The days and order of sightseeing may change to best utilize your time on tour.

****White water rafting is subject to the operator's safety restrictions.**

During our stay in Tortuguero, you will be staying in an eco-lodge. This is an experiential stay that will expose you to amazing wildlife. The rooms are rustic and basic but comfortable. There is a ceiling fan but no air conditioning available. Tortuguero National Park lodges can only be accessed by motorboat.

Hotel check-in on your day of arrival is 3:00 p.m. Rooms may not be available prior to that time.

Many accommodations can be spread out, and you should be prepared to walk on a variety of terrains to get to public spaces like resort lobbies and restaurants. You may need to access your room through outdoor pathways.

Elevators and air conditioning are not available in most accommodations used on this tour.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

Smaller coaches, which may not be lavatory equipped, may be used on this tour. In this case, frequent stops are made during travel periods.

*Due to luggage size and weight restrictions on the boats, please bring an overnight bag for the 2-night stay in Tortuguero National Park. Your main luggage stays in San Jose and joins you upon your return to the mainland.

To complete your tour, we include round-trip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.

Please be advised, many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

Once everyone has had time to practice and review the commands and “high-fives” you will embark on your journey down the rapids. Get wet and wild as you navigate rapids on your 1.5 hour adventure down the beautiful and tropical river. Enjoy the majestic foliage of the rainforest as you watch for monkeys, sloths, and toucans while you raft. You will come to understand the meaning of Costa Rica’s favorite saying, “Pura Vida!” End this tour with a traditional Costa Rican lunch and celebrate your watery adventure! The minimum age to participate is 8 years old. *Duration: Approximately 6 hours.* Please note a minimum of 10 passengers is required. Transportation is included.

Envelop yourself in Costa Rican culture at Finca Don Juan. Explore this family-owned farm, getting a peek into the daily lives in this part of Costa Rica. Day 12: San Jose - Medellín, Colombia

Fly to Medellín, a lively city nestled in the Andes. Once marred by conflict, Medellín has transformed into a hub for innovation, art, and culture. After settling into your hotel, enjoy an evening at leisure to explore the city's renowned restaurants and nightlife.

Day 13: Medellín

Discover an authentic side of Medellín on a private tour that explores a community's transformation from its troubled past. Stroll through streets adorned with powerful murals and connect with local residents who share inspiring stories of how creativity and resilience reshaped their surroundings. Afterward, enjoy lunch downtown at a local restaurant before visiting Plaza Botero, home to 23 bronze sculptures by renowned Colombian artist Fernando Botero. Then, step inside the Museum of Antioquia to admire more of his signature "Boterismo" style — defined by its voluminous, expressive forms. Tonight is yours to explore the city at your own pace. *Today breakfast and lunch will be included.*

Day 14: Medellín - Cartagena

Travel into the hills outside Medellín to the quiet village of Santa Elena, the birthplace of Colombia's iconic silletero culture. Visit a traditional flower farm where you'll learn the art of crafting *silletas* — elaborate floral arrangements featured in Medellín's famous Feria de las Flores. Enjoy a home-cooked meal surrounded by blooming gardens. In the afternoon, fly to the tropical port city of Cartagena and settle into your hotel in the enchanting Walled City (UNESCO). Just outside your door, cobblestone streets, boutique shops, and lively restaurants await. *Today breakfast and lunch will be included.*

Day 15: Cartagena

Begin your day with a guided visit to Castillo San Felipe de Barajas (UNESCO), the most impressive fortress built by the Spanish in the Americas. This 17th-century stronghold, with its coral stone walls and hidden tunnels, was designed to protect Cartagena from pirates and invaders. Your guide will bring its dramatic history to life, including the legendary defense against the British invasion of 1741. Continue with a walking tour of the Walled City, weaving through charming streets lined with colonial homes, flower-draped balconies, centuries-old churches, and lively plazas. The afternoon is yours to enjoy Cartagena at your leisure. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 16: Cartagena

Today, venture just 30 minutes outside Cartagena to the peaceful Afro-Caribbean fishing village of La Boquilla. Begin with a lively drumming and dancing performance led by local artists who preserve their cultural heritage through rhythm and movement. Then join a beginner-friendly workshop and try the drums yourself. Afterward, glide through the village's mangrove-lined waterways by canoe, as a local guide shares insights into the ecosystem, the importance of mangroves, and the wildlife that thrives there. Return to your hotel for lunch on your own and some free time to relax. This evening, immerse yourself in Cartagena's culinary traditions with a hands-on cooking class that features local ingredients and regional dishes. Savor the meal you've prepared as you toast to the final night of an unforgettable journey. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 17: Cartagena - Tour Ends

Your Colombian experience comes to an end this morning in Cartagena. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Important Tour Extension Information:

The overall activity level of this extension is a level 3. This means walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal for you. You can navigate hills and uneven ground, climb into various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.), and could possibly anticipate changes in elevation. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable as is climbing 3 flights of stairs. You can handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. You can expect some longer days balanced with free time. This level is not a fit for travelers that require mobility assistance devices.

This is a Hosted Extension. Enjoy a mix of time on your own and some planned tour activities. A local expert is available during part of your stay to guide you during scheduled activities and provide recommendations. In addition, your accommodations, daily breakfast, and any transfers to connect with your main tour are included.

Medellín is a mountainous city with steep streets, which can make walking challenging for some travelers. This itinerary includes two experiences that involve navigating hills on foot. During the Medellín neighborhood tour, expect several inclines to fully explore the community. While visiting Castillo San Felipe de Barajas, you will need to walk up slopes to access key areas.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

Cartagena enjoys a tropical climate year-round with high humidity and daily temperatures in the high 80s to low 90 degrees Fahrenheit (32 degrees Celsius).

The highest elevation on this tour will be 8,400 feet (2,560 meters) in Santa Elena.

Order of sightseeing is subject to change.

The community visited in Medellín is an authentic neighborhood that reflects the daily life of many local residents. It is a less affluent area, and visitors may notice modest housing conditions, stray dogs, and other aspects of urban life. These elements are part of the community's reality and contribute to understanding its history and culture. Travelers are encouraged to approach the experience with respect and an open mind.

Accommodations in Cartagena are located inside the Walled City (UNESCO). As the majority of hotels are historic in the walled city, room sizes may vary and there may not be elevator access at your hotel.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

Air inclusive rate is valid for travelers who have purchased our air package for the full tour, depending on the air schedule selected. Rate may vary for those who have purchased their own air.
